O R D E R

Pacific Gas and Electric Company applies for authority to exercise a fifty-year electric franchise granted by the City of Sutter Creek, Amador County, under the Broughton Act of 1905. Applicant for many years has rendered electric service within the City under certain asserted county franchises. Public hearing has been held and it is evident that the requested authority should be given.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and hereby is granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to exercise the right or privilege under that certain franchise granted by the City of Sutter Creek by Ordinance No. 76 of January 3, 1938 subject to the condition, how-

ever, that no claim of value for such franchise or the authority hereby granted, in excess of the actual cost thereof, shall ever be made by the grantee before this Commission or before any court or other public body.
