FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 31440 of November 5, 1938, in the above entitled application, Cole McGee, a city and highway contract carrier, was authorized to transport paper, paper articles and related commodities within the Los Angeles Drayage Area, for Fibreboard Products, Inc., at rates lower than the established minimum rates, for a period of one year. By supplemental application, an extension of this authority for another year is sought. It is alleged that the conditions existing at the time the original application was granted continue to exist at the present time without material change.

It appears from the application that authority similar to that heretofore enjoyed by applicant is justified for a further temporary period and should be granted without additional public hearing. By Decision No. 32515 of October 24, 1939, as amended, in Case No. 4121, however, rates substantially the same as those which applicant was previously authorized to charge herein were provided for transportation within the Los Angeles Drayage Area by carriers generally. This adjustment will become effective January 1, 1940, and the authority herein renewed will be limited, therefore, to December 31, 1939.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Cole McGee be and he is hereby

authorized to assess and collect for the transportation for which rates are provided in Appendix "A" of Decision No. 31440, in the above entitled application, rates less than the minimum rates heretofore established by the Commission but not less than those provided in said appendix.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authority herein renewed shall expire on December 31, 1939, unless sooner changed, cancelled or extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
