O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a side track at grade across Tujunga Avenue, an unopened street in Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be such that grades of approach not exceeding six per cent will be feasible in the event Tujunga Avenue is opened to public use. This order, however, is not to be construed as authorization for the opening of said street across the railroad tracks. Within sixty days from the date of this order applicant shall file certified copy of franchise or permit from the City of Los Angeles for construction of said side track across Tujunga Avenue.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
