O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct additional traffic lanes of State Highway Route 4 across the Oakdale Branch of Southern Pacific Company near Merced, Merced County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. DC-161.8. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than thirty feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. ^{1-A} ~~2~~ crossing signs. (G.O. 75-⁸~~2~~).

HEM

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
