
ORDER

ORIGINAL

California Western Railroad and Navigation Company is
authorized to construct a spur track and a side track at grade
across Fir Street in Fort Bragg, Mendocino County, at the location
described in the application. The side track crossings shall be
identified as a portion of Crossing No. 17-0.7, and that of the spur
track as Crossing No. 17-1.1-C. Applicant shall bear entire con-
struction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or
superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation
and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded,
with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach
not exceeding six per cent. Protection shall be by Standard No. 1
crossing signs. (G. O. No. 75-A).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order,
applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authori-
zation shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless
time be extended) or if above conditions are not complied with.
Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience,
necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective
immediately.
