ORDER

WHEREAS Manteca Telephone Company, operating a telephone system in Manteca, San Joaquin County, California, and vicinity, having filed with the Railroad Commission of the State of California an application for authority to make effective a schedule of charges for moving subscribers, telephone sets and for changing from one type of telephone set to another, and

WHEREAS the Railroad Commission has heretofore recognized the propriety of making such charges which have been made effective generally by California telephone utilities; and, it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is required,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Manteca Telephone Company may charge and collect the Move and Change Charges set forth in Exhibit "A" attached to the application, effective for service on or before February 1, 1940, provided the schedule therefor is submitted to the Railroad Commission for filing not later than ten (10) days immediately preceding its effective date.
