ORDER

Southern Pacific Company has made application to abandon its non-agency station of Cameron alleging that no passenger or carload freight business has been transacted at said station for more than two years, that during this period but two less-than-carload shipments were handled, and that continued maintenance of the station is not necessary. It appearing that a public hearing is not required in this matter and that the application should be granted,

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Cameron, County of Kern; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
