SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER MODIFYING DECISION NO. 32566 AND ORDER DENYING PETITIONS FOR REHEARING

By Decision No. 32566 of November 14, 1939, the Commission established minimum rates, rules and regulations for the transportation of property in dump trucks throughout California by radial highway common and highway contract carriers and carriers as defined in the City Carriers' Act. Thereafter, petitions for rehearing were filed by Pacific Rock and Gravel Company and by John D. Gregg. Additionally, the Pacific Rock and Gravel Company filed its petition for modification of the boundary lines of Production Area "N" contained in Original Page 21 of City Carriers' Tariff No. 6 - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 7 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32566) in order to include within the area railroad facilities.

The Commission has carefully considered each of the petitions for rehearing and each and every allegation therein contained and is of the opinion that no good cause for the granting thereof has been therein made to appear. Accordingly, the petitions will be denied. The Commission is of the opinion, however, that the boundary revision sought by Pacific Rock and Gravel Company should be made, and hence the petition for modification filed by the latter company will be granted.

The Commission also is of the opinion that Original Page 39 of City Carriers: Tariff No. 6 - Highway Carriers: Tariff No. 7 should be modified to make clear the application of hourly rates for the transportation of property in dump trucks. This change will be made.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. That Decision No. 32566, in the above entitled proceedings be, and it is hereby amended by substituting in and adding to City Carriers' Tariff No. 6 - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 7 the new and revised pages attached hereto and hereby made a part hereof, which pages are numbered as follows:

3. That the petitions for rehearing filed by Pacific Rock and Gravel Company and John D. Gregg in the above entitled proceedings be and they are hereby denied.

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4. That in all other respects Decision No. 32566 of November 14, 1939, shall remain in full force and effect.
