O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct side tracks at grade across Pine Street, Mono Street, and an unnamed street in Friant, Fresno County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossings Nos. BS-229.7, BS-229.9 and BS-230.2. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadways, and with grades of approach not exceeding six per cent. Protection shall be by two (2) Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
