

Decision No. 32642

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of CALIFORNIA WATER & TELEPHONE COMPANY, CARMEL DEVELOPMENT COMPANY and a COMMITTEE OF CARMEL HIGHLANDS WATER USERS (a) to transfer and acquire the water distribution system at Carmel Highlands; (b) for cancellation and issuance of certificates of public convenience and necessity; (c) for order fixing rates; (d) for release of certain property from its dedication to public use; and (e) for order approving a certain contract dated September 7, 1939, relating to the foregoing matters.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the portion of the Commission's Decision No. 32600, dated December 5, 1939, in the above numbered proceeding, wherein the present rate schedule of the California Water & Telephone Company*, a corporation, is referred to and set forth on page six (6) of the original opinion herein, be and it is hereby modified and amended to read as follows:

Monthly Minimum Charges

1/2 inch and 3/4 inch service	\$1.10
1 inch service	1.50
1 1/2 inch service	2.25
2 inch service	4.50
3 inch service	8.00
4 inch service	12.00
6 inch service	16.00
8 inch service	24.00

Each of the foregoing "Monthly Minimum Charges" will entitle the consumer to the quantity of water which that monthly minimum charge will purchase at the following monthly quantity rates.
