ORDER REVOKING ORDER

By Decision No. 31311, dated September 26, 1938, Steve Abgaroff was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to establish and operate a common carrier automotive service, for the transportation of passengers and baggage between Dunsmuir, on the one hand, and Government Camp at the Shasta Dam Site of the Central Valley Water Project, on the other hand.

Except for the filing of an acceptance of the certificate as granted, this applicant has not, to date, complied with other conditions of the order requiring the filing of tariffs and time schedules in a form prescribed by or acceptable to the Commission.

Under date of November 30, 1939, applicant Abgaroff advised the Commission in writing that he had never operated his stage line and did not intend to do so.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 31311 be and it is hereby revoked and annulled, and the operative right created thereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
