GARDNER, Co-partners, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automobile passenger, baggage and freight service as a common carrier for compensation, between Ferndale and South Fork, California, and Application No. 20153 all intermediate points, via Petrolia and Upper mattole, California. BY THE COMMISSION: OKDEK OF REVOCATION In a letter dated November 28, 1939, O. W. Clark and F. A. Gardner, doing business as Mattole Valley Stage Line, have requested the Commission for authority to abandon the automotive passenger stage and truck service now being provided by said Clark and Gardner under a certificate horetofore issued by the Commission in Decision No. 29548, dated February 19, 1937, on the original application in this proceeding. Said Decision No. 29548 authorized said service between Ferndale and South Fork, and all intermediate points, via Petrolia and Upper mattole.

As justification for the relief sought applicants allege that the revenues derived from the services provided are insufficient to pay the operating expenses in connection therewith and that they are financially unable to continue such operations.

This is not a matter requiring a public hearing and we are of the opinion that the authority sought is in the public interest and it will, therefore, be granted.

Good cause appearing.

IT IS ONDERED that O. W. Clark and F. A. Gardner, doing business as mattole Valley Stage wine, are hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon the automotive service as a common carrier of passengers, baggage and freight between Ferndale and South Fork, and intermediate points, via Petrolia and Upper Mattole, and the operative right therefor, heretofore created by Decision No. 29548, dated February 19, 1937, on Application No. 20153, is hereby revoked and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER OWDERED that all tariffs and time schedules of O. W. Clark and F. A. Gardner, now on file with the Commission and in effect, showing rates and service between Ferndale and South Fork and intermediate points, are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
