O R D E R

The City of Oakland is authorized to construct 81st Avenue at grade across the tracks of The Western Pacific Railroad Company in that city at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 4-12.3. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Western Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines including maintenance of the wigwag. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. 75-B) and one Standard No. 3 wigwag.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
