## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By supplemental application herein, applicant seeks a continuation for one year of the temporary authority heretofore granted by Decision No. 31597 of December 27, 1938, in this prol ceeding. The present authority, by the terms of the decision, will expire on December 27, 1939, unless sooner cancelled, changed or extended by the Commission.

Public hearing on the supplemental application was had before Examiner Bryant at Los Angeles. However, the time allowed the Commission between the date of submission and the expiration date of the present authority is insufficient for an adequate and proper consideration of the record now before it. For this reason the authority should at this time be extended for an additional period in order to permit proper consideration of the evidence and to remove uncertainty on the part of the carrier and shipper involved. This action will be without prejudice to whatever conclusions the Commission may reach upon a full consideration of the record in this proceeding. Therefore, good cause appearing,
