SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By supplemental application herein, applicant seeks a continuation of the temporary authority heretofore granted by Decision No. 31487 of November 28, 1938, as amended in this proceeding.¹ The present authority will expire on December 31, 1939, unless sooner cancelled, changed or extended by the Commission.

Public hearing on the supplemental application was had before Examiner Bryant at Los Angeles. However, the time allowed the Commission between the date of submission and the expiration date of the present authority is insufficient for an adequate and proper consideration of the record now before it. For this reason the authority should, at this time, be extended for an additional period in order to permit proper consideration of the evidence and to remove uncertainty on the part of the carrier and shipper involved. This action will be without prejudice to whatever conclusions the Commission may reach upon a full consideration of the record in this proceeding. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted by Decision No. 31487 of November 28, 1938, as amended, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby extended to February 29, 1940, unless sooner cancelled, changed or extended by appropriate order of the Commission.
