## THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By supplemental application Walter C. Hulsman, an individual doing business as Walter C. Hulsman Trucking Company, a highway contract carrier, seeks a one year extension of the authority granted to him by Decision No. 31035, as amended, in the above entitled application, to transport beer, wine and empty carriers returning, under contract with Grace Bros. Brewing Co. and Grace Bros. Inc., between the Santa Rosa wineries and breweries of those companies on the one hand and San Francisco, Redwood City, San Jose, Monterey, Oakland, San Leandro, Stockton, Sacramento, Woodland, Willows, Marysville, Oroville, Chico and Redding on the other hand, at rates less than the established minimum rates. It is alleged, in substance, that the conditions existing at the time the original authority was granted still exist to the same extent and in the same degree and manner and that no new conditions have since arisen to obviate the need for this authority in the future.

This does not appear to be a matter in which a public hearing is necessary. The supplemental application will be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Walter C. Hulsman be and he is hereby authorized to assess and collect rates less than the established minimum rates but not less than the rates set forth in Appendix "A" of Decision No. 31035 of June 27, 1938, as amended, in the above entitled application, for the transportation of beer, wine and empty carriers returning for Grace Bros. Brewing Co. and Grace Bros. Inc., between the points specified in said Appendix "A".

IT IS MERSEY FURTHER ORDERED that the authority herein granted shall expire on December 31, 1940, unless sooner changed, cancelled or further extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective December 31, 1939.
