ORDER

The people of the State of California on relation of the Department of Public Works are authorized to construct

Sepulveda Boulevard (Road VII-LA-158-LA) at grade across the San Fernando line of Pacific Electric Railway Company near the intersection of Brand Boulevard in the City of Los Angeles at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 6K-26.07. Construction expense shall be borne in accordance with agreement in effect between applicant and Pacific Electric Railway Company. Applicant shall bear maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not loss than fifty feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 3 of C.O. 72.

Protection shall be by one Standard No. 4 (side of street type) wigwag (G.O. 75B), the installation cost of which shall be borne in accordance with the agreement in effect between applicant and Pacific Electric Railway Company. Maintenance of this
