O R D E R

ORIGINAL

The United States of America is authorized to construct at grade a public road across the Lakeview Branch of Southern Pacific Company near Alturas, Modoc County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. CFB-462.9. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G.O. 75-B).

Upon completion, Crossing No. CFB-463.0, about 400 feet northerly, shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, application shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
