New Crossing No. 2-26/1.2 - Rosecrans Street, San Diego Existing - One (1) standard crossing sign and one (1) standard No. 3 wigwag. New Two (2) wigwags, Standard No. 7. Crossing No. 2-885.4 - Summer Street, Bakersfield Existing - One (1) No. 3 wigwag. New - Two (2) flashing light signals, Standard No. 8. Crossing No. 2-1121.3 - El Dorado Street, Stockton - One (1) standard crossing sign and human flagman Existing for a sixteen-hour period. New - Two (2) flashing light signals, Standard No. 8. It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore; -1IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is hereby authorized to make changes in crossing protection as stated above.
