ORDER

Southern Pacific Company has made application for authority to construct its main line track and side tracks at separated grades over and under certain roads and highways between Redding and Delta in Shasta County, State of California. The tracks are those required in connection with the reconstruction of applicant's main line made necessary by the Shasta Dam project, and the cost of relocation, including the cost of constructing the grade separations, is to be borne by the Federal government.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct its main line track and side tracks at separated grades over or under various streets, county roads, and State highways in Shasta County, as illustrated below, said crossings to be identified as indicated:

C-276.2-A	State Highway No. 3 (U.S. Highway 99, -do-)
C-279.6-B	State Highway No. 3 (U.S. Highway 99, -do-)

Said crossings shall be constructed substantially at the locations as shown on the maps and prints attached to the application.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be in accordance with agreement between the several parties, a copy of which shall be filed with this Commission within one hundred and twenty (120) days from the date of this order. Clearances shall conform to provisions of our General Order No. 26-C.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. This order shall be effective immediately.
