FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Charles B. Holbrook, doing business under the name of Holbrook Transit Company, having filed, in the above entitled matter, a supplemental petition in which he requests permission to execute a conditional sales contract, for the purpose of acquiring, at a total cost of \$2,140.54, an additional motor bus, said purchase price to be payable as follows; cash \$54.94, and the balance in monthly installments of \$86.90, commencing on February 12, 1940; and the Commission having considered applicant's request, and it being of the opinion that its Decision No. 32583, dated November 28, 1939, in this matter should be amended so as to permit applicant to execute an additional conditional sales contract and acquire an additional motor bus, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 32583, dated November 28, 1939, be, and the same is hereby amended so as to permit Charles B. Holbrook, doing business under the name of

Holbrook Transit Company, to execute a conditional sales contract in substantially the same form as the conditional sales contract marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the supplemental petition filed in this matter on January 2, 1940.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 32583, dated November 28, 1939, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
