O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company has made application to abandon its non-agency station of Nadine alleging that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at said station for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary. It appearing that a public hearing is not required in this matter and that the application should be granted,

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Nadine, County of Glenn; to eliminate said name from its station records; to abandon and remove a spur track located at said station; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
