BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern California Freight Lines, a corporation, having asked permission to enter into a conditional sales contract with Yellow Truck and Coach Manufacturing Company covering the purchase of a tractor at a cost of \$8,518.04, of which \$605 is payable in cash and the balance, \$7,913.04, in monthly installments over a period of 36 months, the first payment being due one month after the date of the contract, and to enter into a conditional sales contract with Fruehauf Trailer Company of California for the purchase of eight Fruehauf semi-trailers at a cost of \$22,115.32, payable in monthly installments over a period of 36 months, the first payment being due on February 5, 1940, and the Commission having considered applicant's requests, and it being of the opinion that applicant has need for said equipment to replace old and obsolete equipment, and that there is no need for a hearing on this application and that this application should be granted subject to the provisions of this order, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Southern California Freight Lines be, and it is hereby, authorized to execute after

the effective date hereof and prior to April 1, 1940, conditional sales contracts similar in form to the conditional sales contracts filed in this proceeding for the purpose of acquiring said tractor and said eight semi-trailers.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the authority herein granted will become effective when applicant has paid the fee prescribed by Section 57 of the Public Utilities Act, which fee is Thirty (\$30) Dollars.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that within thirty (30) days after the execution of the conditional sales contracts herein authorized, Southern California Freight Lines shall file with the Railroad Commission a certified copy of each of said conditional sales contracts.
