FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the provision of the order in Decision No. 7048, dated January 17, 1920, reading-

"(b) A depreciation reserve of \$750 per annum in installments of \$62.50 per month shall be set aside in a special fund for the purpose of maintaining the plant in good condition and shall be used for such purposes only or as may be authorized by the Commission"

be, and the same is hereby vacated and set aside.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that The Sanger Telephone Company shall maintain a depreciation reserve and make credits and debits to such depreciation reserve in compliance with the system of accounts prescribed by the Railroad Commission for Class C telephone utilities.
