## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 32605, dated December 5, 1939, on Application No. 23078, Oregon-Nevada-California Fast Freight, Inc. and Sacramento-Corning Freight Lines, Ltd. were authorized by this Commission to establish joint rates for the transportation of property between Sacramento, on the one hand, and points on the lines of Oregon-Nevada-California Fast Freight, Inc., between Redding and Bayles, including Bayles, but excluding Redding, on the other hand, for a period of at least sixty (60) days from the date above referred to.

By supplemental application, the above-named applicants now seek to have the period of time for continued publication of said joint rates extended, alleging that conditions previously requiring the relief heretofore afforded thereby, are still in effect to the same extent and in the same manner as at the time of filing of the original application herein.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

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Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the period of time for the publication of joint rates heretofore authorized by Decision No. 32605 be and it is hereby extended for a period of six (6) months from February 5, 1940, unless extended by further order of the Commission, subject to the condition that applicants herein shell publish and file on not less than one (1) days' notice to the Commission and the public a tariff or tariffs conforming to the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
