O P I N I O N

By application filed June 19, 1937, Circle Truck Company, a corporation, sought authority under Section 11 of the Highway Carriers' Act to establish a rate for the transportation of property by dump trucks at less than the minimum rates prescribed by the Commission in Decision No. 28636, dated May 25, 1936, Case No. 4087, for such transportation. Under the application a rate of \$2.12 per hour per truck was proposed for the use of two dump trucks of four cubic-yard capacity in transporting dirt for the State of California within the Eureka Highway District.

A public hearing was held at Los Angeles on August 4, 1937, at which time request for dismissal of the application was made by applicant. Good cause appearing, therefore, the application will be dismissed.

O R D E R

Circle Truck Company, a corporation, having filed the above entitled application for authority to charge less than minimum rates and dismissal having been requested at the public hearing held thereon,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same is hereby, dismissed.
