ORDER

The verified application of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Ladrillo for more than one year and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Rail-way Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Ladrillo, County of San Diego, to retire Siding No. 1, Spur Tracks Nos. 3 and 5 and the passenger shelter at said station, to eliminate said name from its station records, and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
