In this application Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, asks for authority to enter into an agreement with Loomis Mining Company for the sale and diversion of such quantity of excess water as the Pacific Gas and Electric Company may have available in its Boardman Canal, Placer County. Deliveries are to be made from said canal and the flow is not to exceed twenty (20) miner's inches. The agreement is to be effective for a period of two years and from month to month thereafter for a period not exceeding six months.

It is stated in the application that the water to be diverted under the agreement herein is surplus water not dedicated to public use and is in excess of that required by the Pacific Gas and Electric Company to meet its requirements in hydro electric power production and service to its regular irrigation and domestic consumers.

<sup>(1)</sup> A miner's inch for the purpose hereof shall mean a continuous flow of water equivalent to 1.5 cubic foet per minute.

IT IS MEMBERY ORDERED that Pacific Cas and Electric Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the cale and delivery of excess water to Loomis Mining Company under the same terms and conditions substantially as set forth in Exhibit "A" of Exhibit No. 1 which is attached to the application herein and made a part hereof by reference. The amounts and the period of diversion provided therein are at all times to be subject to the authority of the Commission in the exercise of its jurisdiction.

IT IS HERESY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, file with this Commission, within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order, two certified copies of said agreement as finally consummated.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Facific Gas and Electric Company, a comporation, notify this Commission of the date of termination of said agreement within thirty (30) days thereof.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
