BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of
the County of Orange for an order
authorizing the construction and
maintenance of a temporary crossing
over the Pacific Electric Railway
Company's tracks and right of way at
Tiffin Street, Sunset Beach, Orange
County, California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

The County of Orange is authorized to construct fifth
Street, across the Newport line of Pacific Electric Railway
Company at Sunset Beach, Orange County, at the location described
in the application, to be identified as crossing No. 62-27-60.
Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance
cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric
Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.
Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty feet and grades
of approach not greater than four per cent. Construction shall
be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. C. 72. Protection
shall be by two Standard No. 2 crossing signs. (G. C. 75-5).
Within thirty (30) days after completion, pursuant to
this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.
The crossing authorized herein is to be temporary only
and shall be abandoned and removed at applicant's sole expense
within two years from the date hereof, unless further time is
granted by subsequent order.

This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
