In the Matter of the Application of the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing construction of a crossing at separated grades of the State highway and the tracks of the Southern Pacific Railroad, six miles south of Gilroy, in the County of Santa Clara, State of California. ) Application No. 23248

ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State highway IV-SCI-2-C at separated grades over the main line track of Southern Pacific Company near Sargent Station, Santa Clara County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-87.7-A. Applicant shall bear construction and maintenance expense. Applicant shall file with the Commission within one hundred and twenty days: (1) a copy of an agreement entered into between the parties relative to the construction and maintenance of said crossing, and (2) plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company. (Clearances shall conform to the provisions of G. O. No. 26-C). The existing overhead crossing No. E-86.4-A of said State highway shall be maintained for local use.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if conditions are not complied with. This order shall be effective immediately.
