FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In connection with the construction of a grade separation at Polhemus Street, San Jose, heretofore authorized in this application in Decision No. 32596, it is necessary to construct a temporary cross-over track across Stockton Avenue in said city, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a crossover track at grade with Stockton Avenue in the City of San Jose, said crossing to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. E-45.65. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded. Upon completion of the grade separation at Polhemus Street said crossover track shall be removed.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
