## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

San Francisco and Mapa Valley Railroad, applicant in the above-entitled proceeding, has filed a supplemental application requesting authority to abandon portions of its former main line and yard tracks in the City of Mapa. Applicant states that no public service has been rendered over these tracks since September 30, 1937, that portions of the tracks are in a state of disrepair and should be removed, and that the continued maintenance of these tracks interferes with street improvements desired by the City of Mapa.

Good Cause Appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that San Francisco and Mapa Valley Railroad be authorized to abandon portions of its former main line and yard tracks in the City of Mapa as described in the supplemental application filed February 6, 1940.
