By his application filed January 28, 1938, Peter H. Muller, to whom had been issued permits authorizing operation as a radial highway common carrier and as a city carrier, sought authority under Section 11 of the Highway Carriers' Act and under Section 10 of the City Carriers' Act to establish a rate for the transportation of property in dump trucks below the minimum rates prescribed by the Commission for that service by Decision No. 28836, dated May 25, 1936, in Case 4087. Applicant proposed a rate of \$1.00 per hour for hauling dirt and other material in his 2-cubic-yard dump truck in connection with certain W.P.A. projects in the City and in the County of Los Angeles. Applicant has requested that this proceeding be dismissed, and the matter will be disposed of accordingly.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled proceeding be, and it is, hereby dismissed.
