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SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 31833 of March 20, 1939, in this proceeding, authorized Los Angeles-San Francisco Navigation Company, Ltd. to suspend for a period of one year its service as a common carrier by vessel for the transportation of freight and passengers. By supplemental application filed March 8, 1940, applicant seeks authority to continue the suspension of its service for a further period of one year. It alleges that the conditions found to justify the original suspension have not changed materially but that there is a possibility of a favorable change in the future which will enable applicant to resume service.

In Case No. 4394 the Commission has before it, among other things, the matter of determining to what extent, if at all, future suspensions of service by coastwise common carriers by vessel will be justified. Applicant will be authorized herein to suspend service without public hearing for a further period of six (6) months. A joint hearing will be scheduled in Case No. 4394 and in this sup-

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plemental application for the purpose of determining whether or not an extension beyond that date should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Los Angeles-San Francisco Navigation Company, Ltd. be and it is hereby authorized to continue the suspension of its common carrier by vessel service for a period of six (6) months from the effective date of this order.
