BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, on January 18, 1940, applied for authority to single track its Whittier Line between Walker and Whittier, Los Angeles County, California, Applicant proposes to remove that portion of its inbound track, as described in paragraph V of the application and as shown in yellow on the map (C.E.H. 16274-a), attached thereto, thereby effecting a saving of some \$5,500 per year in maintenance of way and structures expense.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to single track its Whittier Line between Walker and Whittier, in accordance with the plan above described.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
