O R D E R

The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, are authorized to construct State Highway 6-A at separated grades under the track of Southern Pacific Company in Solano County, near the county line, at the location as shown on the map (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. A-74.9-B. Construction and maintenance expense shall be apportioned in accordance with agreement entered into between the parties. Applicant shall file a copy of said agreement and plans of said crossing, approved by Southern Pacific Company, within one hundred and twenty (120) days from the date of this order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of G.O.26-C.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if conditions are not complied with. This order shall be effective immediately.
