BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The City of Glendale is authorized to construct Glenoaks Boulevard at grade across the Glendale Line of Pacific Electric Railway Company at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6G-9.08. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with the terms of an agreement between applicant and Pacific Electric Railway Company, copy of which has been filed with the Commission. Width of crossing shall be not less than fifty (50) feet and grades of approach not greater than three (3) per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 3 of G.O. 72.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
