ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By application filed March 27, 1940, Chester McNutt, a radial highway common and highway contract carrier, sought authority under Section 11 of the Highway Carriers' Act to assess rates less than the established minimum rates for the transportation of lumber and forest products from San Diego to points in the Imperial Valley. On April 2, 1940, however, Decision No. 32964 was entered in Case No. 4246, in re Rates of all Common and Highway Carriers, authorizing the application of the sought rates by carriers generally and removing the need for special authority to this applicant.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and it is hereby dismissed.
