FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

In the above entitled application Independent Paper Stock Company, a corporation engaged, among other things, in transporting property as a highway contract carrier, was granted authority under Section 11 of the Highway Carriers' Act to transport pulpboard from the plant of Fibreboard Products, Inc. in Vernon to the plant of that company in Southgate, at a rate less than the established minimum rate. This authority was granted for a period of one year, expiring April 18, 1940.

Applicant now requests that the authority be extended for a further period of thirty days. It states that it desires the authority to be made permanent, but that additional time is necessary for the preparation of an appropriate application.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that extension of the authority for a further period of thirty days is justified.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted by Decision No. 31930 of April 18, 1939, in the above entitled application be and it is hereby extended to May 18, 1940.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
