BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The verified application of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company discloses that no passengers and but two shipments of freight have been handled at applicant's station of Greenwood during the past two years, and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Greenwood, County of Sonoma, to retire a spur track, to eliminate said name from its station records, and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
