ORDER

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Jacksnipe for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof as a point for receipt and delivery of freight is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to change its Class "D" non-agency station of Jacksnipe, County of Solano, to a Class "E" station, and to cancel all freight tariffs applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after the change in classification, as authorized herein, is put in effect, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
