

Decision No. 23343

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing the construction of a crossing at grade of the state highway and the tracks of the Pacific Coast Railway, six miles south of San Luis Obispo, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California.) Application No. 23343

O R D E R

The Department of Public Works is authorized to construct at grade State Highway Route 2 across the main line track of Pacific Coast Railway Company near San Luis Obispo, San Luis Obispo County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 31B-5.8. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Coast Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than forty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G. O. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
