In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY, for an order authorizing the construction at grade of a side track across Waterman Avenue at the Station of Loma Linda, County of San Bernardino, State of California. } Application No. 23421.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a side track at grade across Waterman Avenue, in San Bernardino County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-541.6.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by one additional Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O.75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this Order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This Order shall be effective immediately.
