THIRTY-SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In the Thirtieth Supplemental Order in the above-entitled application, Decision No. 32719, dated January 9, 1940, East Bay Transit Company was granted a certificate to operate a motor coach line over certain streets in the City of Richmond for a ninety-day experimental period. The City of Michmond agreed to the proposed operation on the ninety-day trial basis. The service was established on January 20, 1940, over the following route:

> From the intersection of Tenth Street and MacDonald Avenue, along Tenth Street to Barrett Avenue, along Barrett Avenue to 23rd Street, along 23rd Street to Garvin Avenue, along Garvin Avenue to Key Boulevard, thence returning via the same route to the point of beginning.

East Bay Transit Company has written the Commission that during the first sixty days the operations failed to meet out-ofpocket expenses by \$433.82 and that it does not seek an extension of this operative right.

Good Cause Appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate for operation of the motor coach line over the above-described route as authorized in Decision No. 32719 is hereby revoked.
