SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 31930 of April 18, 1939, as amended, in the above entitled application, Independent Paper Stock Company, a highway contract carrier, was authorized to transport pulpboard from the plant of Fibreboard Products, Inc. in Vernon to the plant of that company in Southgate, at a rate less than the established minimum rate. This authority will expire May 18, 1940. By supplemental application filed April 27, 1940, indefinite continuance of the authority is sought. It is alleged that, since the authority was granted, applicant has experienced no material change in its operating conditions or its costs of performing this service, and that there is no reasonable expectation of any substantial changes in the future.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that a temporary extension of the authority is justified. It does not appear, however, that an extension of more than one year should be made at this time, since it is manifestly not possible to foresee the conditions which may prevail at the expiration of that period.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted by Decision No. 31930 of April 19, 1939, as amended, in

the above entitled application, be and it is hereby extended to May 18, 1941.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
