THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 30938 of May 31, 1938, as amended, in the above entitled application, Ira P. Lamb, a city and highway contract carrier, was authorized to transport grain, grain products and related commodities under contract with Sperry Flour Company, between points within defined areas in southern California, at rates less than the established minimum rates. This authority will expire June 1, 1940. By supplemental application filed May 8, 1940 an extension of the authority is sought. It is alleged that since the authority was granted applicant has experienced no material change in operating conditions and that operations under the authorized rates have been profitable.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that an extension of the authority for a further period of one year is justified. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted by Decision No. 30938 of May 31, 1938, as amended, in the above entitled application, be and it is hereby extended to June 1, 1941, subject to earlier change, cancellation

or further extension by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective May 31, 1940.
