FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Pacific Gas and Electric Company having by letter of May 1, 1940, filed a further agreement with The Permanente Corporation dated April 22, 1940, wherein and whereby Section 1 of its agreement with said The Permanente Corporation dated September 28, 1939, has been amended to provide for service of surplus gas to two cement kilns and one lime kiln instead of three cement kilns and one lime kiln at the latter's cement plant located in the County of Santa Clara, State of California, and it appearing that Applicant's request is reasonable and should be granted and that a public hearing in the matter is not necessary and good cause appearing;

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company is authorized to enter into that certain amended agreement dated April 22, 1940, copy of which is attached to its letter dated May 1, 1940, in which said agreement amends Section 1 of agreement dated September 28, 1939, heretofore authorized by Decision No. 32340 dated September 19, 1939, in the above numbered application.

In all other respects Decision No. 32340, dated September 19, 1939, and said agreement dated September 28, 1939,

shall remain in full force and effect.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
