ORDER

ORIGINAL

The City of North Sacramento is authorized to widen the existing crossing at grade of El Camino Avenue across the track of Sacramento Northern Railway in said city, identified as Crossing No. 8-97.1, as described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, including the cost of moving the existing crossing protection, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Sacramento Northern Railway shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B) and one Standard No. 3 wigwag.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
