ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By this application Fred Jordt, a city and radial highway common carrier, sought authority under Sections 10 and 11 of the City and Highway Carriers' Acts, respectively, to assess rates less than the established minimum rates for the transportation of used household goods and personal effects of decedents, for the account of the Public Administrator of Los Angeles County. Subsequent to the filing of the application, however, the transportation of used household goods and personal effects for the United States, state, county and municipal governments was exempted from the application of the established minimum rates. (Decision No. 32325 of September 19, 1939, as amended, in Case No. 4086.) The need for special authority to this applicant thus having been removed, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and it is hereby dismissed.
