ORDER REVOKING PASSENGER OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Written request having been made under date of May 23,
1940, and

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that E. E. McClure, operating under the
name and style of Covelo Stage Line, be and he is hereby authorized
to discontinue and abandon all of his operative rights as an auto-
motive common carrier of passengers between Covelo and Dos Rios and
intermediate points, as heretofore acquired under Decision No. 20246,
dated September 21, 1928, subject to the following condition:

Applicant shall immediately prepare and file, in
triplicate, and on at least five (5) days' notice
to the Commission and the public, a supplement to
his tariff cancelling rates, rules and regulations
covering the service herein authorized to be
abandoned and shall further similarly file a
cancellation of his passenger time schedule.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
